
NOW I feel much better. Anger management really does work.




A while back, they had a contest to pick the world's funniest joke. Did you see that? No – me either. There was one and here is the winner:

Here are a few one-liners from my younger days (the 1950s and 1960s) by two of my favorite comedians, Bob Hope and Red Skelton:



"I grew up with six brothers. That's how I learned to dance - waiting for the bathroom."


"Everything Reagan does, Gorbachev does him one better. Reagan wears the flag of his country on his lapel. Gorby wears the map of his country on his forehead."
